We are the only CARF accredited program in Southern Colorado.

During the 2017 year, our facility served 300 patients while providing over 10,800 total hours of rehabilitation services to our community. The average age of the person served by the program is 66 years old and our patients' ages range from 19-96 years of age.

Our Team of Professionals work together to ensure the best confidential and ethical care possible and

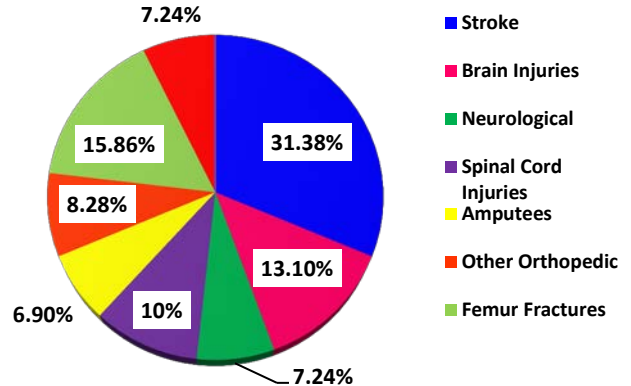

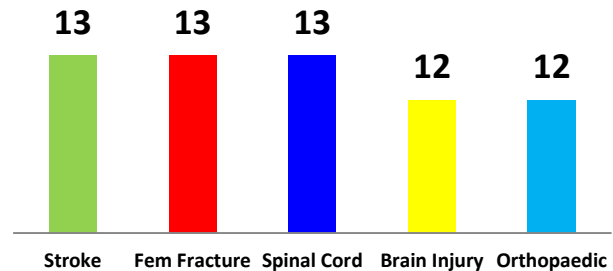

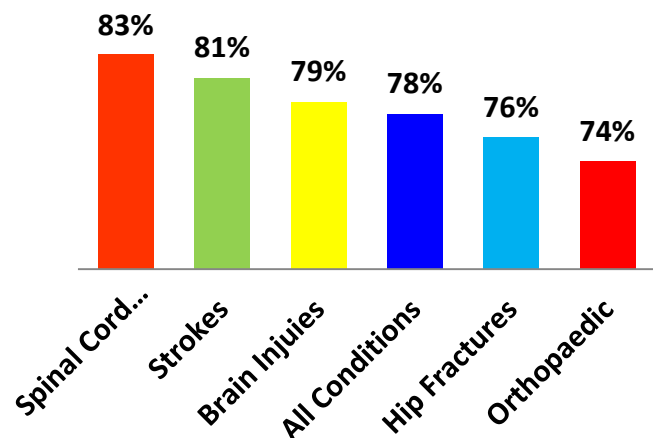
Types of conditions we treat



Average days patients stay on our unit



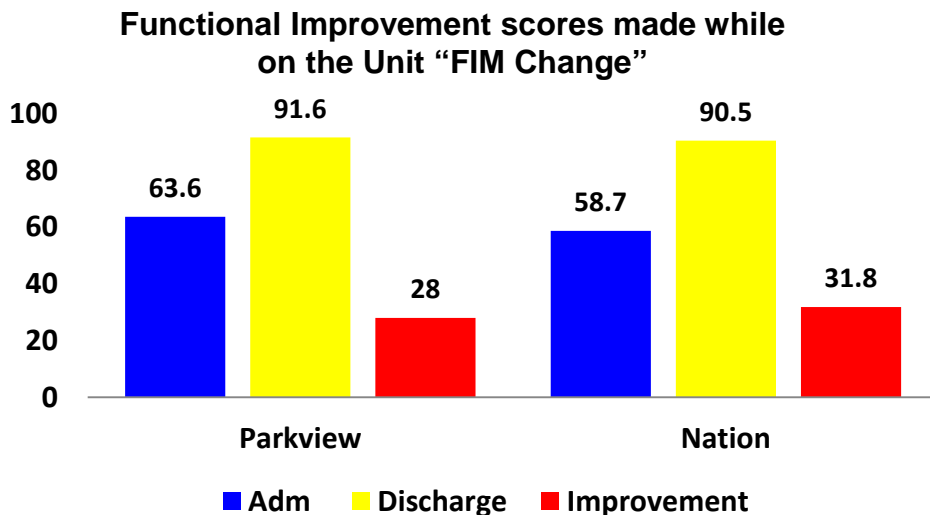
Individuals that return home to the Community from our Rehab Unit



Continuum of Care

Our Rehab services do not end when you are discharged. Our continuum of care has a full range of services which are available to assist you to return to the quality of life you so want! We offer outpatient services at 2 locations for patients discharged from the hospital, as well as homecare services. This will help you to continue to improve after your are discharged from us. We also have monthly Support Groups such as, the Stroke Support Group, the Brain Injury Support Group, and the Parkinson's Support Group.

**FIM" - Functional Independence Measure is a measurement of a patient's functional level consisting of 13 motor and 5 cognitive measures. FIM is scored on a 0-7 scale with 7 being independent and 1 being total dependent.

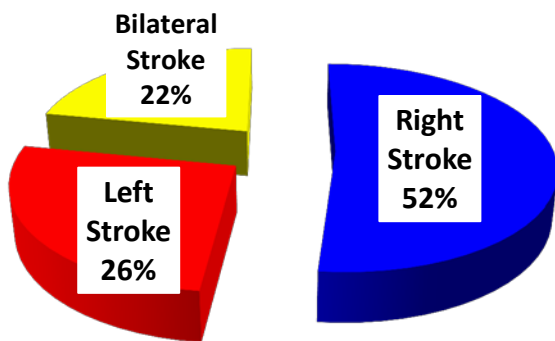


The Stroke Program

Parkview Center for Rehab has been Stroke CARF Certified since 2007.

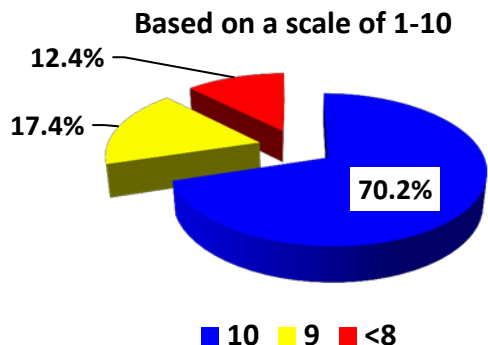
